

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP LIST & REQUIREMENTS

DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 22, 2021

AHS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Must have attended a full senior year at AHS and attend the alumni reunion your first year. Must be a good citizen with good moral character. Must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements. Scholarship may be deferred for one year, upon request. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach one or two letters of recommendation from people that know you well
- Attach copies of exhibits for achievements for scholarship, leadership, or athletics
- Must attend Ashland Alumni Function (TBD)

AHS DRAMA CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to an initiated Thespian who has actively participated in Drama Club and Thespians for the past two years, and has shown leadership as an officer, head of a fundraiser, or another leadership event that benefits AHS Theatre. Must have a GPA of 3.4 or higher. Must have earned a school letter in Theater.

AHS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a graduating senior and a member of National Honor Society. Based on community service and leadership. May be deferred for one year, upon request.

ASHLAND EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Eligible applicants must have attended AHS for three years, and be a graduating senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Must have a parent or guardian who is a certified teacher for the Ashland School District. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- List your parent/guardian's full name and title (page 5)

ASHLAND FOOD CO-OP CULINARY SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to students planning to pursue a culinary arts program at an accredited school. Open to AHS/GED students, who meet eligibility requirements. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- State what culinary program you plan to attend and where (page 5)
- State if you have been accepted, and when training will begin (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)

ASHLAND LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Must attend an **Oregon** public college or university, no private schools. You may request a one-year deferral.

Supplemental Requirements:

- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach an unofficial transcript

ASHLAND MASONIC LODGE #23 SCHOLARSHIP

Intended for a graduating AHS student pursuing further education. Interviews may be conducted. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach an unofficial transcript

ASHLAND ROTARY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Student must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater, financial need, academic achievement, community service and employment are considered. Open to AHS student who meet all eligibility requirements. **Rotarian's children or grandchildren are not eligible to apply.** This scholarship is renewable for a second year, if in good standing for a second college year. This scholarship may **not** be deferred. Interviews conducted. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Is your parent/guardian or grandparent a Rotarian? If so, what is their name? (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach unofficial transcript

THE BILL SCHOLARSHIP

For a graduating senior student who was late in discovering his or her purpose and direction. Student will attend a non-profit accredited college or trade school. No minimum GPA. Financial need is considered. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Describe your purpose in life and how you discovered it (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach two letters of recommendation

CARPENTER GRANT FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Evidence of need is highly considered. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements.

Supplemental Requirements:

- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach unofficial transcript

CHAPTER AC P.E.O. TINA WALLIS SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a senior **FEMALE**. Based on academics, activities, and financial need. This scholarship may **not** be deferred. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Social Security Number – last four digits only (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach two letters of recommendation from an AHS teacher and/or counselor
- Attach unofficial transcript

DAVID STEELE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Graduating senior planning to attend a 2 or 4-year college/trade school to pursue a public safety degree or certification through career and technical education (CTE). Examples include the following: EMS, EMT, fire fighter, police officer, paramedic, corrections officer, dispatcher, forestry, etc. This scholarship also applies to pursuing the medical field such as nursing and medical technicians. Minimum GPA of 3.0. **Background:** *The Steele family seeks to help an AHS graduating senior with a scholarship of \$2,500 to enable them to pursue a career in a public service or medical field. David Steele graduated from Ashland High School in the Class of 2007. While at Ashland High School, David played football and rugby and enjoyed learning in hands-on study structural fire science to pursue his emergency medical technician certification. While fighting a fire in the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, David lost his life in a helicopter accident. We honor David's memory with this scholarship.* **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Attach an unofficial transcript

HELMAN ELEMENTARY ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

Evidence of need, good citizenship and moral character, and determination to further your education.

Supplemental Requirements:

- How many years did you attend Helman Elementary? (page 5)
- One or two letters of recommendation from people who know you well
- Attach copies of exhibits for achievements, scholarship, leadership, or athletics
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)

KIWANIS CLUB OF ASHLAND ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP

Recipient must have lettered in at least one AHS team sport, and a minimum of 200 hours of community service. GPA of 3.0 or greater. You may request a one-year deferral if needed. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Write a 300-word essay about your community service and how it has prepared you for adulthood (page 5)
- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Attach an unofficial transcript

KIWANIS "KEY CLUBBER OF THE YEAR" SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to a senior student who has also been recognized as a "Key Clubber of the Month." You may request a one-year deferral, if needed. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach an unofficial transcript

KIWANIS TOMMY LAIRD SCHOLARSHIP

Only students who have been a "Kiwani Student of the Month" are eligible to apply. You may request a one-year deferral, if needed. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach an unofficial transcript

KIWANIS VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP OF ASHLAND

The Kiwanis Club of Ashland seeks to help a graduating senior with a \$1,000 scholarship that will enable the student planning to enroll in an unaccredited vocational/trade school program to pursue his/her career goals (electrical, plumbing, hair stylist, etc.). The student will be selected by Kiwanis Club representatives based on need and expected success, with no restriction to field of study or the choice of school. Minimum academic cumulative GPA of 2.5. Financial need will be considered. This scholarship may not be deferred. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Student will notify Kiwanis Club of Ashland the timeframe of student's vocational training attendance, and acknowledge receipt of monies to their school account. Notification must be made to Ashland Kiwanis Club at P.O. Box 449 – Ashland, OR 97520
- Student is invited to attend a general meeting of the Ashland Kiwanis Club to be introduced to membership.
- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Attach an unofficial transcript
- Describe leadership skills and community service (page 5)
- Complete Financial Information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)

KIWANIS YOUTH FOUNDATION OF SOUTHERN OREGON SCHOLARSHIP

Available for freshman year at an accredited college or trade school. **GPA must be between 2.0 (no lower) and 3.0 (no higher)** in order to apply. You may request a one-year deferral, if needed. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Attach an unofficial transcript

LEAH CASTILLO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a graduating senior, using one or more of the following criteria: minority student, interest in art or foreign language, and community interests. **Background:** *On graduation night of 2005, Leah Castillo was killed in an alcohol-related auto accident while on her way to the all-night graduation party. To honor her memory, we wish to give others who exemplify the qualities that this wonderful young woman possessed, a helping hand in furthering their educational goals.*

LITHIA SPRINGS ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to students planning to enroll in a vocational program at a career school or community college. Financial need is considered. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements.

Supplemental Requirements:

- What classes have you taken to prepare for your career path, and how did these classes help you? (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the "SAR" page from FAFSA (1st page only)

MIMI SCHOLARSHIP

Recipient will have a “never give up” spirit that is evident in his or her endeavors. No GPA requirement and grades are not of primary importance. Based on financial need, and commitment to help others in school and in the community. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Autobiography essay about your financial need and commitment to helping others. Help the sponsor of this scholarship know who you are, and how you epitomize the “never give up” spirit (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the “SAR” page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach two letters of recommendation from school or a community member who knows you well
- Attach unofficial transcript

OSEA – OREGON SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION CHAPTER 42 SCHOLARSHIP

Eligible applicants must have at least one parent/guardian (including step parent) who is a “full share” classified member in good standing of OSEA Chapter 42 (regardless of which school the senior is graduating from). Student is pursuing education beyond high school at any accredited university, community college or vocational school. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater. **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Name and title of parent/guardian/step parent that is a classified member of OSEA Chapter 42 (page 5)
- Attach one letter of recommendation
- Attach unofficial transcript

SOROPTIMIST VICKI SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a **FEMALE** senior graduate with a minimum 3.25 GPA. You may request a one-year deferral if needed.

Background: *Soroptimist International is an organization committed to improving the lives of women and girls locally and globally. Vicki Smith was a 25+ year-old Soroptimist who passed away in March 2010. She cared deeply about young people, helping them to find their way to achieve success and live healthy and fruitful lives. We honor Vicki Smith with this scholarship in her name.* **Supplemental Requirements:**

- Attach two, one-page (maximum) letters of recommendation from people who can speak about your ability to do college work, achieve your goals, and/or participate in community service (community members, employers or teachers). Unsolicited materials will be discarded (extra recommendations).
- Attach an unofficial transcript
- Attend Soroptimist Awards Luncheon in May (TBD)

SOROPTIMIST VO-TECH SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a **FEMALE** senior graduate who is vocationally-bound to pursue her career goals. The student will be selected based on need and anticipated success. Open to AHS/GED students who meet all eligibility requirements.

Supplemental Requirements:

- Describe classes you have taken to prepare you for your chosen career, and how the classes helped (page 5)
- Complete financial information (page 6), and attach the “SAR” page from FAFSA (1st page only)
- Attach two letters of recommendation
- Attach an unofficial transcript
- Attend awards luncheon in May (TBD)

THE SPLINTER GROUP SCHOLARSHIP

The ‘Splinters’ are a group of Ashland-based, design and build professionals with the intention of providing education and support to the community through their works and collaboration. Awarded to an AHS senior that can be applied toward tools/mentoring/employment, in the pursuit of careers in the building and design trades.

Supplemental Requirements (page 5):

- Are you available for guidance opportunities in the summer of 2021 – Yes or no?
- Please list your general work experience
- Please list any construction experience you may have (class work, training, design, on-job)
