PARENT'S RIGHTS IN IDENTIFICATION, EVALUATION AND PLACEMENT

(PLEASE KEEP THIS EXPLANATION FOR FUTURE REFERENCE)

The following is an explanation of your rights. The intent of the rules and regulations is to keep you fully informed concerning decisions about your child.

1. RIGHT TO REVIEW ALL SCHOOL RECORDS

You have the right to see and examine all school records related to your child. The district will supply you, upon request, a list of the types and location of education records collected, maintained or used by the district. If you feel that certain records are inaccurate or misleading, you have the right to ask that they be removed from your child's file. Copies of any material pertaining to your child will be available to you, upon request, at reasonable cost.

2. RIGHT TO REVIEW EVALUATION TESTS AND PROCEDURES

You have the right to examine all tests and procedures that will be used to determine if your child is in need of special services, and what his/her educational needs are.

3. RIGHT TO REFUSE TO PERMIT EVALUATION OF YOUR CHILD

You have the right to withhold permission for your child to be tested.

4. RIGHT TO BE INFORMED OF THE RESULTS OF EVALUATION(S)

You have the right to have the results of all testing with your child explained to you.

5. RIGHT TO WITHHOLD CONSENT FOR YOUR CHILD TO INITIALLY RECEIVE SPECIAL SERVICES

You have the right to refuse special services.
